Amanda Spann is an innovation strategist, serial app entrepreneur and podcaster. With a knack for simplifying the complexities of technology, she creates products and programs to help entrepreneurs and enterprises take their ideas from concept to creation. Her latest initiative, The App Accelerator, helps aspiring non-technical app founders to build and brand problem-solving mobile app businesses.

Prior to her current work, Amanda co-founded Tiphub, an impact driven innovation community for entrepreneurs in Africa and the African Diaspora and the hosts of Diaspora Demo Day, once the largest US-based pitch competition for African led startups. She also served as CMO of Blerdology, a tech social enterprise to support and engage the black tech community and the first organization to host hackathons targeting African-Americans. The company worked to spark interest in innovation and assisted minority entrepreneurs build their technology-enabled startups for little to no cost.

Amanda is a member of the Techstars network, a startup mentor at 1871 and has coached, consulted and created content for over 30,000 entrepreneurs around the world. Her work has been featured in Wired, TechCrunch, Fast Company, NPR, Black Enterprise, HLN, Business Insider, Inc, Venture Beat and more.
